Anwa educational Centre is one of non formal schools located in an informal settlement of Kibera in Nairobi Kenya.

The school enrolls from the school going aged children who cannot be accommodated in the few available public schools due to the limited spaces.

It is one of the schools registered to provide education and getting financial assistance to purchase instructional materials in order to enable as many children as possible access to education.

The children are from poor background where some attend classes despite having skipped some meals. Problems include lack of uniforms and other basic commodities. However, the donation of story books has enabled the school to perform well in English and become very competitive among other non formal schools in Nairobi.

Before the donations, the school was not ranked anywhere but after the donations the school was ranked 6th among 1,000 schools in the region.

More donations and other forms of assistance will enable the children to improve on their performance.
